**U.S. ATTORNEY RESPONDS TO CCACB FORMAL COMPLAINT REQUEST**

WILLINGTON, Conn. – Tim Heim, President of the Connecticut Coalition Against Crumbling Basements (CCACB), will hold a **press conference today, Monday, August 14, 2017, at 5 p.m.** at his home in Willington (53 Laurel Drive, Willington, Conn.) to read the response from the U.S. Attorney for the District of Connecticut regarding the federal complaint filed on July 21, 2017, on behalf of dozens of homeowners affected by crumbling concrete.

In the complaint, the coalition asked the U.S. Attorney to conduct a “comprehensive inquiry into, but not limited to, violations, wrongdoing, misconduct, breach of office and/or ethics committed in relation to this concrete crisis.” The complaint included a timeline of details going back to 2001 to highlight the State of Connecticut’s awareness about this crisis.

The letter received by Heim today details the decision of the U.S. Attorney concerning this case and action steps for the coalition moving forward in this matter. Heim will read the letter in full and respond to questions.
